

POSSUM MASTER

KILL TRAP

The 'Possum Master' uses a unique method of trapping and killing pests. It has been designed for both the professional trapper and the domestic user.

Safe to set and easy to remove dead pest. It's simple, lightweight design allows it to be positioned in a variety of locations. For use on possums, mustelids and feral cats. It is safe around domestic animals if not baited with meat or if used with face plate.

SETTING PROCEDURE

WARNING!

Failure to set safety catch as shown in fig 1 may result in premature release of fly-arm causing injury. fly-arm & cord moves quickly.

- Ensure safety catch is in 'SAFE' position.

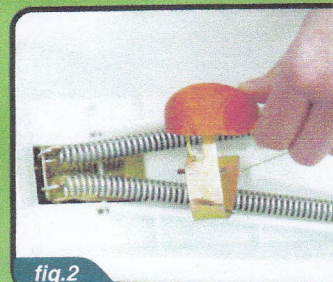

- Push bait onto the bait hook eg. small apple wedge.

- Apply pressure to the front of the trap (with thumb under cord) ready to push fly arm over with other hand.

- Push fly arm down firmly, while pulling cord forward with the thumb.

- Trigger will locate automatically and safety will be on.

- Position noose cord around plastic hooks.

- Position on tree using **only a small headed nail** as shown. Secure cord. Trap will lift off nail and hang on cord when pest is caught.

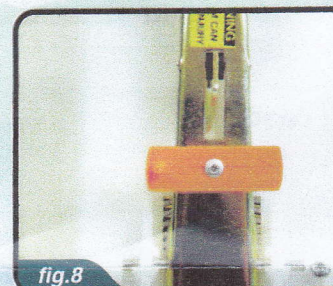
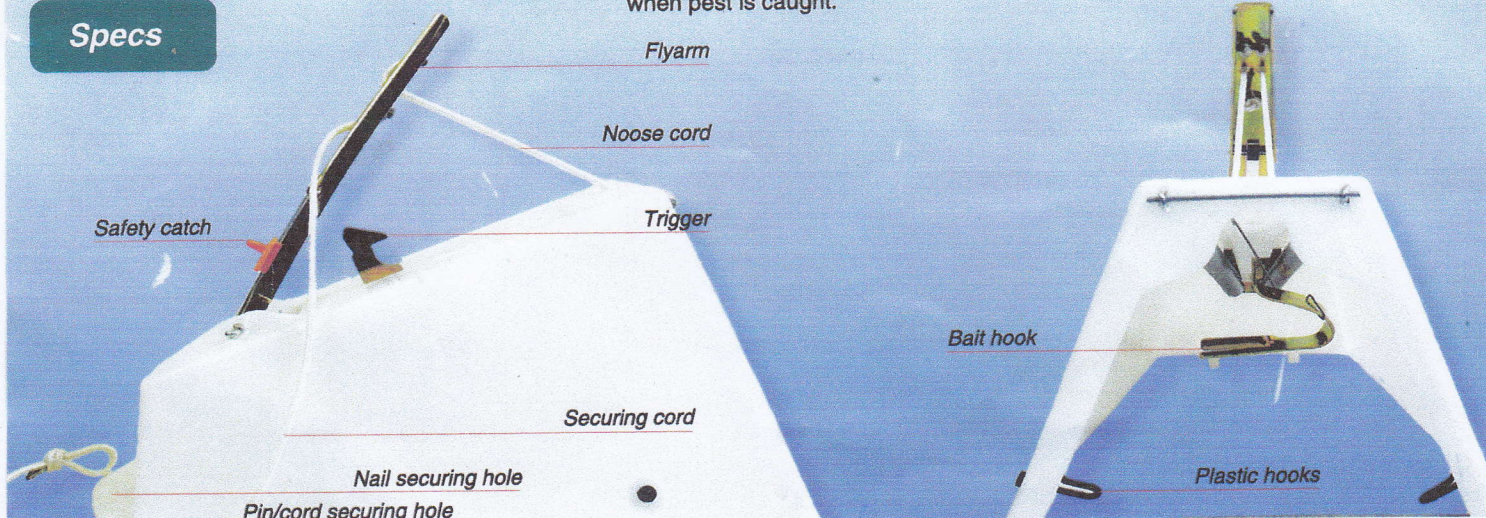

Picture 1 position A	Recommended	Bait Bag: Picture 2 Use a <u>small</u> plastic bag secured by disks or twistie tie to make a long life bait. Slice disk on bait hook, slip bag in between forks and slide second disk on to secure. Faceplate Assembly: Picture 4 <ul style="list-style-type: none">Check safety is on, set trap and pull cord down.Slide faceplate down between carry wire and outer edge of trap.Position top of faceplate in the inside gap between edge and nodule by coPress down until faceplate clips in firmFaceplate and bottom of trap should flush.
